## Course:

The **Cross-Country** course is the same course that we have used at Kingman Farm in the past, and is identical to the one we used last year. The course is a 5 mile loop over rolling terrain featuring fire roads, wide open fields, singletrack and a technical singletrack ascent/ decent filled with switchbacks.

## Directions: Kingman Farm:

-From I-95 take Spaulding Turnpike north to exit 8W (Madbury/ Rte 155). Follow Rte. 155 for 3 miles. Turn right at gate before Kingman Farm (dirt access road). There will be signage. Parking is along the dirt road. Start/ Finish/ Registration is 0 mile down the road.

-From Durham take Madbury Road to the intersection of Rt. 4. At the set of light, go straight through crossing Rt. 4. At the end of Madbury Road, take a right onto Rte. 155 and drive a mile and take a left at the gate.

There are plenty of places to stay in the Durham/ Dover area. We recommend the Holiday Inn Express in Dover; This is the best location. It is just off of exit 8 of the turnpike and is within riding distance to Kingman Farm. Call (603)-742-4100 or contact us if you have problems.
