Historic Bellefonte Criterium - Sat. April 1st

Where: Historic downtown Bellefonte, Centre County, PA. See Exhibit A below.

Registration: Friday 7pm-10pm at [Mt. Nittany Wheelworks Bike Shop](#) in State College.
Saturday and Sunday, all day until 30 minutes before your race starts.

Course: Approximately one-mile loop. Rolling with 4 turns.

Race format: Criterium map included. The race will be run in a counter-clockwise direction. Wheel-pit at start/finish. **Riders deemed out of contention will be pulled from the race. Promoter may combine D fields if there are less than 50 riders.**

Course: 9.5 miles - out and back course, rolling

Race Info: Rider's will have a 1/2 mile ride from the parking area at the middle school down to the start near the intersection of Brush Valley and Linden Hall Roads (**No cars will be allowed down to the Start/Finish**). The race will start by going in a counter-clockwise direction on the map, turning around and returning to the Start/Finish. Bathrooms will be provided in the middle school.

Race format: Rolling Enclosure (no yellow line rule/use entire road). **Road map included.** The race will be run in a clockwise direction. The start will be a neutral rollout from the middle school; the finish will be a climb to the Mount Nittany Winery (1 km @ 6%). **Riders out of the race caravan will be subject to rules of the road.**

Race info: Bathrooms will be provided at the middle school. Teams will be permitted to shuttle riders down from the finish at the winery (**be sure to park in designated areas**). Take some time to check [the winery](#) out when it opens, and pick up the special issue 2006 Nittany Classic wine bottles (provided you are 21).

From the North: Take 87 S to 84 W to 81 S to I- 80 W (see below for directions from 80).

From the West (Pittsburgh): Take 22 E to I-99/ US 220 N towards Altoona, turn Right at traffic light on to US-220 to 322 E towards State College. Get off at Atherton Street ramp. You'll be on Atherton for 2.5 miles then look for Snappy's gas station and turn left right before it. Follow into parking lot. Shop is on the right.

From Allentown: Take I- 476 N to exit 95 I-80 W (see below for directions from 80).

From the East (New Jersey) Rt. 80 Westbound: Take exit 161 towards Bellefonte (stay left at fork off of ramp to US -220S/26 S approximately 11 miles) follow signs towards Innovation Park/ Penn State Univ./ Beaver Stadium becomes Park Avenue. Stay Straight on Park Avenue for about 2.5 miles then turn right at "T" onto Atherton Street. Go approximately 1 mile then turn right immediately after Snappy's convenience store. Follow into parking lot. Shop is on the right.

From Host Hotel: Take Village Drive back out to Atherton Street, Turn right on N. Atherton Street, Turn right onto Vairo Blvd., Turn left onto Waddle Road, Merge onto Route 220 North (toward STATE COLLEGE), Merge onto Route 150 North (toward BELLEFONTE), Turn right onto W. High Street / Route 550 North, Turn left onto South Allegheny Street, Elementary School Parking lot is just ahead on the left

From Rt. 80 Westbound: Take the PA-150 S/US-220-ALT S exit number 158- toward MILESBURG/ALTOONA. Merge onto US-220 ALT S. Take the PA-150 S/PA-144 S ramp toward MILESBURG/BELLEFONTE. Follow this into Historic Bellefonte.

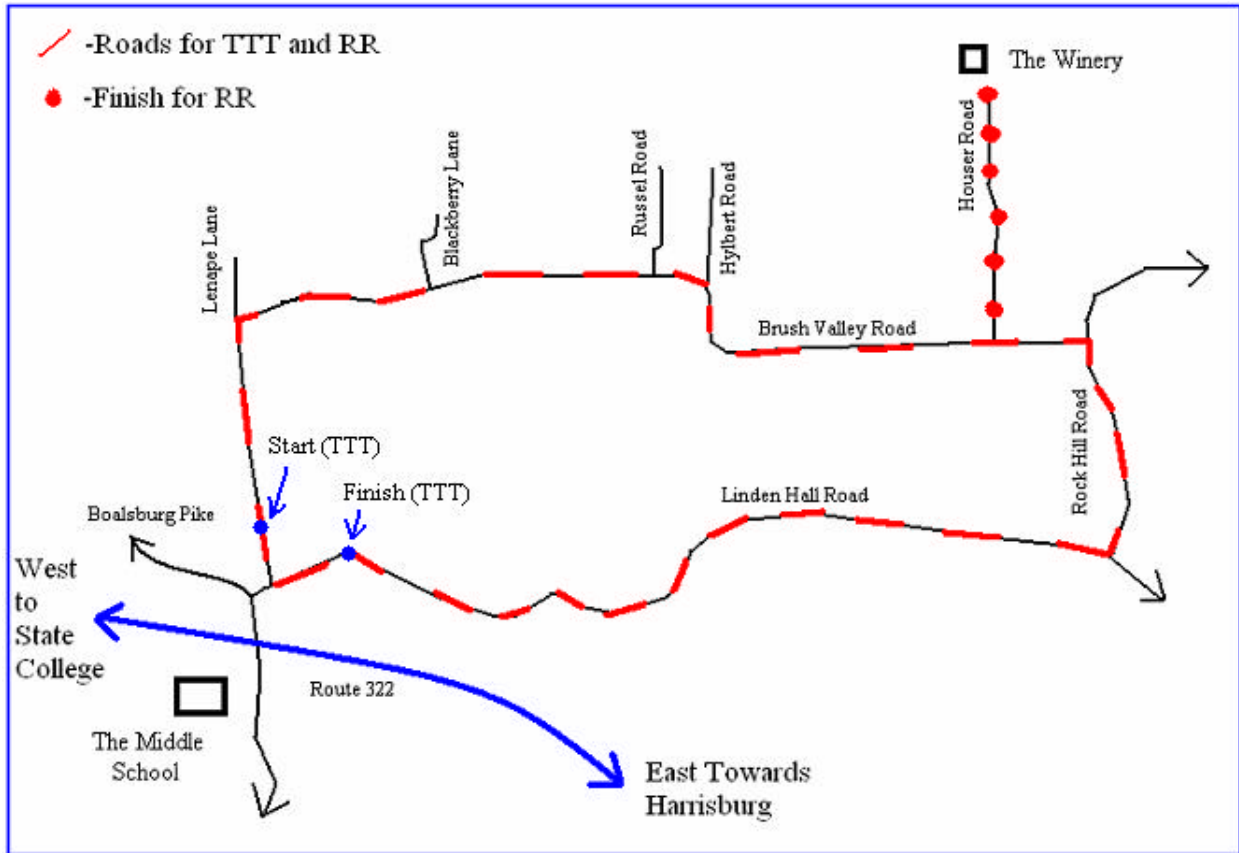
From Crit: Start out going south on N. Allegheny Street (toward W. Lamb Street), Turn right onto W. High Street, Turn left onto Route 150 / S. Water Street, Route 150 become Route 26 / E. College Avenue, Merge onto Route 322 East, Take the exit toward Boalsburg / Route 45 West, Merge onto Boalsburg Pike, Turn Right onto Brandywine Drive, Go up road to the Middle School Parking Lot

From Host Hotel: Take road behind the Mount Nittany Wheelworks' plaza, Turn left at the light onto North Atherton Street, At the top of the hill turn left onto Park Avenue, Merge onto Route 322 East, Take the exit toward Boalsburg / Route 45 West, Merge onto Boalsburg Pike, Turn Right onto Brandywine Drive, Go up to the Middle School Parking Lot

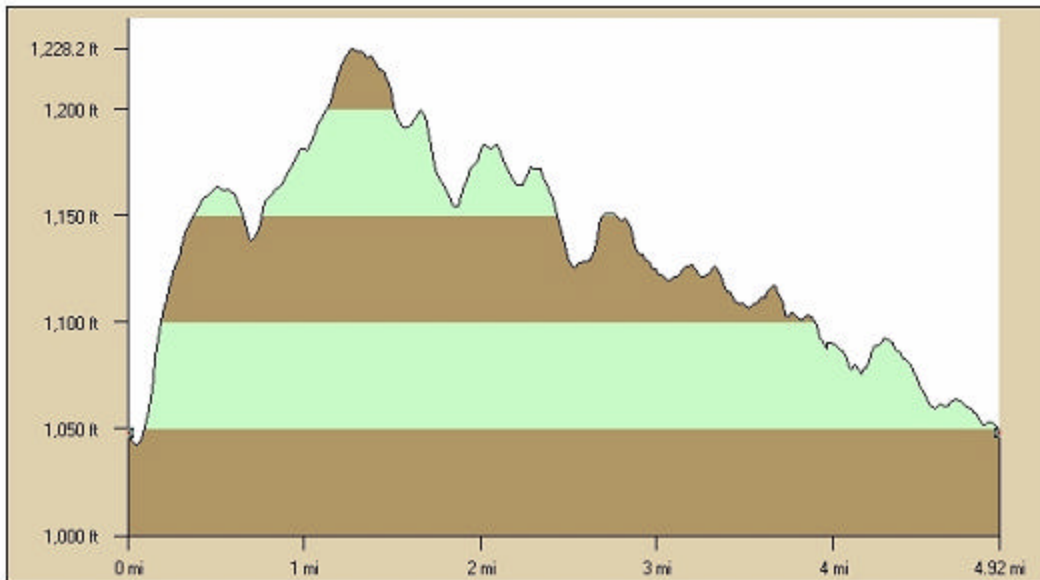
